

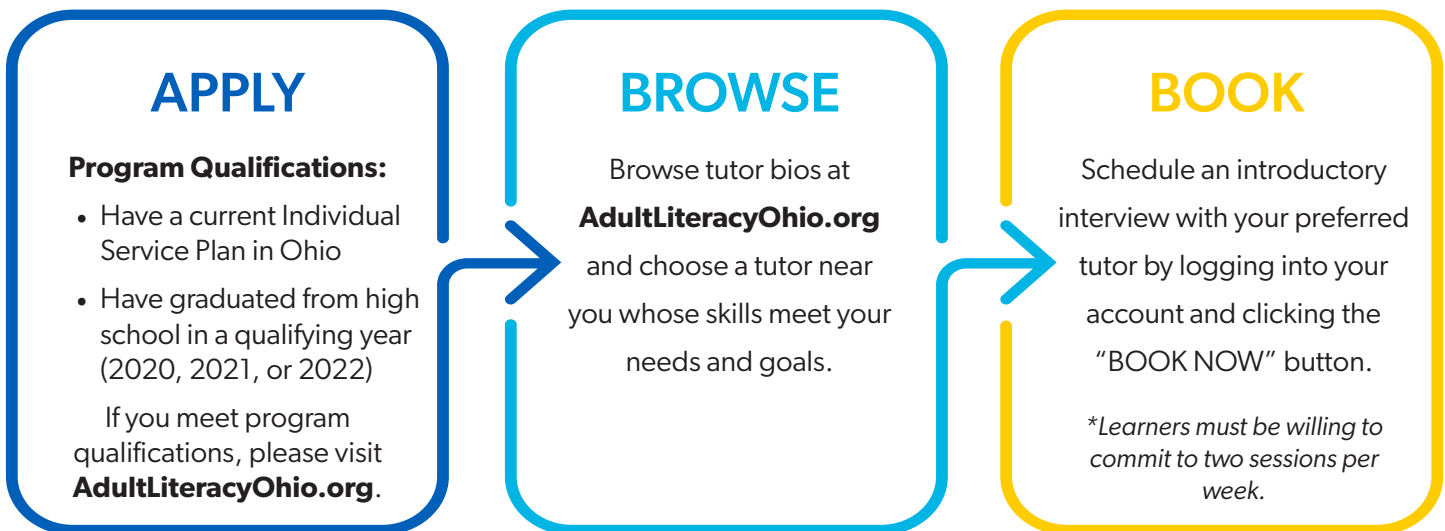


1:1 Literacy Learning Support for Adults with Developmental Disabilities

Adult Literacy Ohio exists to connect adults with developmental disabilities to licensed educators and speech-language therapists who offer 1:1 learning support for improving reading, writing, and communication skills. Our pilot program offers each awarded learner up to \$2500 per session to spend on services through AdultLiteracyOhio.org. Tutors customize content based on the unique abilities of each learner and the goals the learner wants to achieve. Goals can range from learning reading fundamentals (for a non-reader) to gaining specific literacy skills to improve workplace performance. Low literacy impacts the ability to navigate schools, workplaces, and communities. We believe that by equipping our adults with the resources and supports to improve their literacy skills, we are investing in increased independence, greater employment opportunities, and better quality of life.
