Multi-site research study on the health of adults with intellectual disability

The OSU Nisonger Center is **seeking individuals willing to serve as research interviewers** for a national study on prevalence of psychiatric disorders in adults with intellectual disability



Responsibilities:

- Successfully complete CITI and other required research training (approximately 40 hours)
- Become proficient in administering study measures and interviewer procedures
- Schedule and complete virtual research interviews (3-4 hours per interview)
- Adhere to project data collection protocols
- Attend monthly meetings and communicate study progress to research coordinator

Required Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree in psychology, social work or related field
- Reliable high-speed internet and a private work area for conducting virtual interviews
- Detail-oriented and well-organized
- Ability to work well with others as part of a project team
- Minimum of 5 hours of availability per week (20 per month)

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience working with adults with intellectual disability
- Previous experience with conducting structured or semi-structured interviews and/or assessments
- Successfully completed at least one class in abnormal psychology
- Experience collecting or entering data as part of a research project

Compensation:

- \$1,000 training stipend
- \$200 per completed research interview
- \$25 per monthly meeting
