NCBCs are small groups of people with disabilities that meet weekly in their communities to read and hang out together.

Who can join?

Anyone who is 18 and over can join, regardless of reading or ability level.

How does it work?

NCBC members meet weekly for one hour in local libraries and bookstores. During meetings, members get to know each other and read a book they have chosen. Volunteers are there to help as needed. There is no cost to participate.
